AL RULES

Canada Rules Govern All Play

- Penalty Areas are defined by Red Stakes
- ut of Bounds Defined by White Stakes and/or undary Fences
- ut of Play Driving Range Drop ball within 2 club ngths from point of entry. One stroke penalty. No ief from fence.
- ree lift from gardens, staked trees under six feet tall
- ones in bunkers are movable obstructions; refer to GA Rule 24-1
- irway Bunkers on the right side of Hole #15 & le #17 on the Old Course are considered Waste

se replace your divots. If that is not possible, fill divot with the sand/seed mixture provided. Rake ks in bunkers. Carts must remain on the path on par 3s and on paths by all tees and greens. Repair marks on greens. Proper dress code is in effect. nks... and good golfing!

WARNING: LIGHTNING POSES A SERIOUS RISK!

When you suspect that there may

be lightning or hear one long horn blast indicating the possibility of lightning, please immediately seek shelter in the clubhouse, other on-course buildings or automobiles. When none of the above is available, look for dense woods and low-lying areas. Avoid open areas, water, metal, wire fences, power lines and other overhead wires, isolated trees, elevated ground, maintenance machinery and golf carts. Raising umbrellas increases the risk when lightning is near. Two short horn blasts indicate it is safe to return to the course. While the golf shop will endeavor to warn you of lightning, ClubLink is not held responsible for removing Members and Guests from the course.
