



TIPS FOR MAINTAINING PROPER PACE

Encourage your group to play "ready golf": Know when it is your turn to play and be ready to hit your shot as soon as it is safe to do so. Always maintain your position relative to the group in front. Under normal circumstances, you should never be more than half a hole behind that group. A Play Coordinator will assist you if you are having difficulty maintaining your position on the course.

WARNING:

LIGHTNING POSES A SERIOUS RISK!

When you suspect that there may be lightning or hear one long horn blast indicating the possibility of lightning, please immediately seek shelter in the clubhouse, other on-course buildings or automobiles. When none of the above is available. look for dense woods and low-lying areas. Avoid open areas, water, metal, wire fences, power lines and other overhead wires, isolated trees, elevated ground, maintenance machinery and golf carts. Raising umbrellas increases the risk when lightning is near. Three short horn blasts indicate it is safe to return to the course. While the golf shop will endeavour to warn you of lightning, ClubLink is not held responsible for removing Members and Guests from the course.

PIN POSITIONS

Front - Red Middle - White Back - Blue
All yardage indicators are to centre of green

LOCAL RULES

The Rules of Golf Canada Govern All Play

Penalty areas: Defined by red stakes

Out of bounds and lost ball: Local Rule for Stroke and Distance is in play

Out of bounds: Defined by white stakes, boundary fences, and public roads

Fixed Sprinkler Heads: All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions (Relief without penalty is permitted under Rule 24.2). In addition, if the ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and an immovable obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief.

French Drains: All French drains are immovable obstructions (Relief without penalty is permitted under Rule 24.2).

Handicaps are governed by the World Handicap System.

ALCOHOL POLICY
