



General Membership Golf Cart Regulations

It is the policy of Club Renaissance to restrict golf traffic to areas of the course where turf conditions warrant. These restrictions may be implemented due to weather events, maintenance or other hardships incurred by the course during its general operation. During any time period, restrictions may be limited to certain areas of the course or encompass the entire property. Cart restrictions will be decided on a daily basis and solely at the discretion of the Club Renaissance golf leadership team.

- 1) Members are to obey all cart rules, sign, ropes and instructions.**
- 2) Members may not drive carts onto sloped areas surrounding the green, particularly the front and side areas.**
- 3) Members may not advance past posts and ropes positioned across fairways. From this point, golfers must proceed directly to the cart path, staying on the path through the duration of the hole.**
- 4) Members are required to use cart paths near tees and greens areas.**
- 5) Carts should enter and exit all fairways using the 90 degree cart rule.**
- 6) Members must stay on cart paths while playing par 3 holes.**
- 7) Members are asked to use no more than 2 member carts per foursome during the general course of play. The leadership team recognizes that some special circumstances such as smoking or health related issues will**

lend itself to the use of a third member cart. These special circumstances should be limited in scope and must be communicated to the Starter before play. An Extra cart may not be used due to anticipated inclement weather or plain matters of personal convenience.

8) It is also acceptable for a twosome of members to use two member owned carts for play. However use of 3 member carts for a threesome is not allowed.

9) For Clublink owned golf carts 1 cart per two players, two carts per 3 to 4 players. A maximum of two Clublink owned carts per foursome.

10) Members may not drive over any curbs or in any areas protected by curbs.

11) Members should not drive in saturated areas of the course during periods immediately following precipitation or irrigation. Please drive in areas of the rough, whenever possible.

The golf member is agreeing to adhere to the terms of the General Membership Golf Cart Regulations policy and understands that repeated breach of the cart regulations could lead to discussion of cart policies with management, written documentation and up to suspension of playing privileges.



Members with Disabilities Golf Cart Regulations

Club Renaissance may restrict golf traffic to areas of the course where turf conditions warrant. These restrictions may be implemented due to weather events, maintenance or other hardships incurred by the course during its general operation. During any time period, restrictions may be limited to certain areas of the course or encompass the entire property. Cart restrictions will be decided on a daily basis and solely at the discretion of the Club Renaissance golf leadership team.

A Club Renaissance issued Handicap Pass on a golf cart indicates that the owner of that cart has a documented disability and certifies that they are entitled to all aspects of relief specifically designated in the Club Renaissance Members with Disabilities Cart Regulations.

All Members with a medically documented disability may request the use of a Handicap Pass. The Handicap Pass will be issued upon the proper completion and compliance of all aspects of the designated registration form. Signature on the registration form must be renewed annually and states that the Member agrees to abide by all disability regulations set forth by the golf course leadership team.

The following regulations must be observed when using a Handicap Pass:

- 1. An issued Handicap Pass applies only to the individual(s) with the documented disability.**
- 2. If multiple individuals with a documented disability are playing together, we prefer that you ride together.**
- 3. Disabled Members may drive to points 30 feet from the front of the green. Entry beyond the fairway rope system is allowed for the purpose of hitting a**

shot, but should be limited to the least intrusive access necessary. After completion of the shot and arrival of the ball upon the green, drive 90 degrees to the rough area and park on the most level area that is no closer than 10 feet to the back of the green.

4. Parking on the front or sides of the green during putting is prohibited. To access the back of the green, drive on the cart path and enter the rough area before the curbing starts and park on the most level area that is no closer than 10 feet to the back of the green. Due to safety concerns, some areas behind greens will be inaccessible to golf carts and access is prohibited. The Club Renaissance golf leadership team will solely be responsible for designating these areas.

4. When entering and exiting areas near the green, please drive in a varied pattern to assist in preventing golf cart wear patterns from developing.

5. All Members including disabled Members will be prohibited from entering certain areas of the course. The Club Renaissance golf leadership team will solely be responsible for designating these areas.

6. Par 3 holes: Cart Path Only on holes # 12 & # 14. Hole # 4, access to left rough area only, hole # 7, right rough only, no carts are allowed in approach areas on Par 3 holes. Then proceed no closer than 10 feet to the back of the green.

7. When an area of the course is closed or designated as “cart path only” due to weather or maintenance conditions, Handicap Pass members must stay on the cart path in these closed or designated areas.

8. The Club Renaissance golf leadership team may amend these rules at any time and without warning should they deem action necessary to provide for the Membership’s safety as well as preserve the condition of the golf course.
