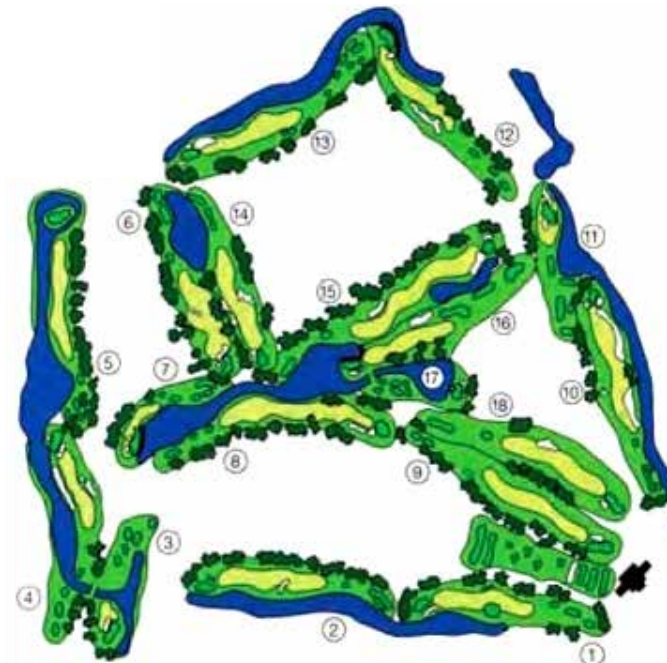

TIPS FOR MAINTAINING PROPER PACE

Encourage your group to play "ready golf": Know when it is your turn to play and be ready to hit your shot as soon as it is safe to do so. Always maintain your position relative to the group in front. Under normal circumstances, you should never be more than half a hole behind that group. A Play Coordinator will assist you if you are having difficulty maintaining your position on the course.

Pace of play should be kept at or below four hours and ten minutes as rated by U.S.G.A. formula.

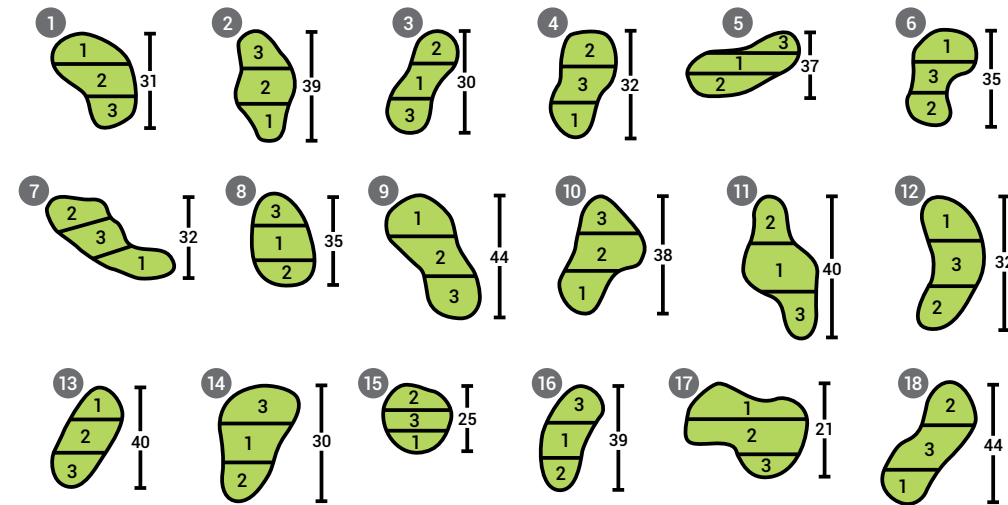
ALCOHOL POLICY

Members and guests are strictly prohibited from bringing their own alcohol onto a ClubLink property in accordance with all applicable liquor licensing regulations.

U.S.G.A. RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY EXCEPT WHERE MODIFIED BY LOCAL RULES.

- The embedded ball rule is in effect "through the green"
- O.B. left of water on holes 1, 2, 3, 4, & 5
- O.B. right of water on holes 10, 11, 12 & 13
- In course O.B. left of holes 11 & 13 and road behind 2, 7, 11 and left of 13
- Stadium seating plays as an immovable obstruction
- One club length relief from ant hills - no penalty
- Wooden bulkheads on holes 7, 12 & 16 are in the hazard
- Waste areas on hole 10 play as "through the green"
- You may remove rocks in bunkers - no penalty
- GPS system is measured to the flag stick.
- Sprinkler yardages are measured to the front, center and back of the greens.
- Carts are restricted to paths on all par threes (holes 3, 7, 11 and 17).

Please fill all divots with green sand mixture, rake tracks in bunkers, keep carts on path wherever possible near tees and greens, repair ball marks on greens, and wear proper golf attire. Thanks... and good golfing!
