## Tips for Maintaining Proper Pace

Encourage your group to play "ready golf":  
Know when it is your turn to play and be ready to hit your shot as soon as it is safe to do so.  
Always maintain your position relative to the group in front. Under normal circumstances, you should never be more than half a hole behind that group. A Play Coordinator will assist you if you are having difficulty maintaining your position on the course.

Golf Canada Rules Govern All Play

- Penalty areas – Defined by red or yellow stakes
- Out of bounds - Defined by white stakes and boundary fences

Please rake tracks in bunkers, repair ball marks on greens and replace your divots. If that is not possible, fill your divot with the sand/seed mixture provided.

Keep carts on paths until the black cart enter posts and return back to the cart path at the black exit post. Driving the carts only on the fairways between the two posts.

Appropriate golf attire must be worn on the golf course and driving range.

## WARNING:

### LIGHTNING POSES A SERIOUS RISK!

When you suspect that there may be lightning or hear one long horn blast indicating the possibility of lightning, please immediately seek shelter in the clubhouse, other on-course buildings or automobiles. When none of the above is available, look for dense woods and low-lying areas. Avoid open areas, water, metal, wire fences, power lines and other overhead wires, isolated trees, elevated ground, maintenance machinery and golf carts. Raising umbrellas increases the risk when lightning is near. Three short horn blasts indicate it is safe to return to the course. While the golf shop will endeavor to warn you of lightning, ClubLink is not held responsible for removing Members and Guests from the course.
