Glencairn Golf Club – Scotch Block, Leithfield, and Speyside

Event Format and Rules of Competition - 3 best gross scores of 5 balls to count on each hole. Men - **Blue Tees**, and ladies – **Red Tees**

Please record the gross scores of each player for each hole on the scorecard along with your aggregate of three best scores for each hole. For pace of play purposes, no player shall take more than a triple bogey. The golf professional in the group is responsible for recording scores. Please turn in your scorecard to the scoring desk in the dining room immediately following play.

Rotation - Groups starting on Scotch Block will proceed to Leithfield # 1 after Scotch Block # 9
 Groups starting on Leithfield will proceed to Speyside # 1 after Leithfield # 9
 Groups starting on Speyside will proceed to Scotch Block # 1 after Speyside # 9

Winning teams and ties from each course will meet on the ninth hole of the Speyside Course for a shootout. Two amateur players (one male, one female) from each winning team will participate. Low aggregate team score determines the winner. In case of a tie for the win, tied teams will go back to the original shootout location and shootout again for the win until the tie is broken.

Play shall be governed by the Rules of Golf and Decisions as approved by the Royal Canadian Golf Association, except as modified by the following local rules. Unless otherwise specified, the penalty for breach of a local rule is two strokes.

- 1) **Suspension of Play:** if it becomes necessary to suspend play, the signal for suspension will be as follows:
 - a) **In a dangerous situation** the signal to suspend play will be one (1) prolonged blast of the horn. Players **must immediately** mark the position of their ball and seek shelter.
 - b) For a normal suspension of play the signal will be several intermittent notes of the horn. The player shall proceed under RULE 6.8b
 - c) The signal for resumption of play will be two (2) consecutive air horn blasts, repeated.
- 2) **Distance measuring devices:** are permitted

Doubts as to procedure (rule 3-3): if a ruling is required or you are uncertain of your rights, Rule 3.3 allows for a second ball to be played out and the two results presented to the Rules Officials at the event scoring desk. Rules Officials for this event will be Brent Miller, Tim Green, and Grant Holcomb.
